

A BILL

FOR AN ACT AMENDING SECTIONS 1683-a, 1683-c, AND REPEALING 1683-e, AND ENACTING A SUBSTITUTE THEREFOR, AND REPEALING 1683-q, OF THE SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE, 1913, AND AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SCHOOLS FOR TEACHING THE SCIENCE OF AGRICULTURE, ANIMAL INDUSTRY, HORTICULTURE, AND DOMESTIC SCIENCE IN THE COUNTIES OF THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That section 1683-a, of the supplement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended by inserting after the word "agriculture" in the second line of said section, the words "domestic science,".

Sec. 2. That article 1, of Section 1683-c, of the supplement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended by inserting after the word "agriculture" in the second line of said article, the words "domestic science,".

Sec. 3. That article 2, of said section 1683-c, of the supplement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words, "The Farm Improvement Association ofcounty, Iowa," which appear in the first and second line of said section, and by inserting in lieu of said words a blank for the name of the corporation.

Sec. 4. That section 1683-e, of the supplement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

Section 1683-e. General Powers. Such body corporate shall have power to establish and maintain a permanent agricultural school, in which the science of agriculture, horticulture, animal industry, and domestic science shall be taught; to employ one or more teachers, experts or advisers to teach, advance and improve agriculture, horticulture, animal industry, and domestic science, in said county, under such terms, conditions and restrictions as may be deemed advisable by the board of directors; to adopt by-laws; to take by gift, purchase, devise or bequest, real or personal property; to have, and exercise all powers necessary, appropriate and convenient for the successful carrying out of the objects of said corporation. It shall have authority to use part or all of the sum annually received as dues from its members in payment of prizes offered in any department of work, including agricultural fairs, short courses, or farmers' institutes.

Sec. 5. That section 1683-q, of the supplement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby
2 repealed.

Sec. 6. In effect. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be
2 in force from and after its passage and publication in the Register and Leader, and the Des
3 Moines Capital, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
