

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO CONTROL OF THE BRIDGE FUND IN CITIES, AS THE SAME APPEARS IN SECTION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT (758) OF THE CODE, AND SECTIONS SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT-a (758-a), SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT-d (758-d), AND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT-e (758-e), OF THE SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE, 1913.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That the law as it appears in section seven hundred fifty-eight (758) of the code
2 be and the same is hereby amended by striking from line one (1) of said section the words
3 “of the first class” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “having a population of five
4 thousand or over”.

Sec. 2. That the law as it appears in section seven hundred fifty-eight-a (758-a) of the sup-
2 plement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended by striking from lines two (2)
3 and three (3) the words “of the first class” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “hav-
4 ing a population of five thousand or over”.

Sec. 3. That the law as it appears in section seven hundred fifty-eight-d (758-d) of the sup-
2 plement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended by striking from lines one (1)
3 and two (2) the words “cities of the first class” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words
4 “such cities”.

Sec. 4. That the law as it appears in section seven hundred fifty-eight-e (758-e) of the sup-
2 plement to the code, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended by striking from line three (3)
3 the words “cities of the first class” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “such cities”.

Sec. 5. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the Register and Leader, a newspaper published in Des
3 Moines, Iowa, and the Cedar Falls Record, a newspaper published in Cedar Falls, Iowa.
