

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO PROHIBIT A CITY OR TOWN FROM EMPLOYING AS AN ENGINEER ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION INTERESTED IN THE PUBLIC WORK OR IMPROVEMENT TO WHICH SUCH ENGINEERING WORK RELATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. No person, firm, or corporation nor any employer, employee, agent or servant thereof who has or may have directly or indirectly any interest in any contract or the proceeds thereof or profits therein for any public work or improvement of any city and town or in the manufacture or sale of any material thereof, or who has or may have during the progress of such work or the making of such improvement any interest in any patents for the manufacture of any materials or for any machines or processes used in such public work or improvement shall be employed by any such city or town as engineer or to draw or make contracts, plans or specifications for such public work or improvement.
