

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To accept the requirements and benefits of an act of congress approved the twenty-third day of February, nineteen hundred seventeen, relating to appropriations to the states for instruction in agriculture, the trades and industries and for the preparation of teachers of vocational subjects; and to provide for the proper custody and administration of funds received by the state for such appropriations.

Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. That the provisions of the act of congress, enacted
2 by the sixty-fifth congress at the second session thereof, entitled
3 an "act to provide for the promotion of vocational education; to pro-
4 vide for cooperation with the states in the promotion of such educa-
5 tion in agriculture and the trades and industries; to provide for co-
6 operation with the states in the preparation of teachers of vocational
7 subjects; and to appropriate money and regulate its expenditure", and
8 approved February 23, 1917, be and the same is hereby accepted.

1 Sec. 2. That the benefits of all funds appropriated under
2 the provisions of such act are hereby accepted as provided in such
3 act.

1 Sec. 3. That the state board for vocational education is
2 hereby designated as the state board as provided in such act, is
3 charged with the duty and responsibility of cooperating with the
4 federal board for vocational education in the administration of
5 such act; and is given all power necessary to such cooperation.

1 Sec. 4. That such state board is hereby authorized to make
2 such expenditures for the salaries of assistants and for such office
3 and other expenses as such state board may deem necessary to the
4 proper administration of the funds allotted to the state of Iowa
5 under the provisions of such act.

1 Sec. 5. That the state treasurer is appointed as custodian
2 of funds for vocational education, as provided in such act; and is
3 charged with the duty and responsibility of receiving and providing
4 for the proper custody and for the proper disbursements on vouchers
5 drawn by such state board, of moneys paid to the state from the ap-
6 propriations made under the provisions of such act.

1 Sec. 6. That the state treasurer as custodian of funds for
2 vocational education shall make to the general assembly, at each
3 biennial session thereof, a report of the receipts and disbursements
4 of moneys received by him under the provisions of such act and such
5 state board shall make to the general assembly at each biennial session
6 thereof a report of its administration of such act, and the expenditure
7 of money allotted to the state under the provisions of such act.

1 Sec. 7. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall
2 be in effect on and after its publication in the Des Moines Register,
3 and the Des Moines Capital, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
