SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION No. 3 *see journals*

Joint Resolution agreeing to a proposed amendment to article one (1) of the constitution of Iowa by adding thereto a provision prohibiting the manufacture, sale or keeping for sale, of intoxicating liquors, as a beverage, within this state.

1 Whereas, by senate joint resolution number six (6) of the
2 resolutions of the thirty-sixth general assembly, which resolution
3 was approved March 8, 1915, an amendment to the constitution of the
4 state of Iowa was proposed, and,

1 Whereas, the said proposed amendment was agreed to by a
2 majority of the members elected to the house of representatives
3 of said thirty-sixth general assembly and entered upon its
4 journal at page five hundred eighty-nine (589) thereof, and was
5 agreed to by a majority of the members elected to the
6 senate of said general assembly and entered upon its journal at pages
7 three hundred and twenty-six (326) and three hundred and twenty-
8 seven (327) thereof, and,

1 Whereas, the said resolution has been published as pro-
2 vided by law and has now been referred to this, the thirty-seventh
3 general assembly, now, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 That the proposed amendment to the constitution of the
2 state of Iowa as contained in and proposed by said senate joint
3 resolution number six (6) of the resolutions of the thirty-sixth
4 general assembly, which resolution, including its title, was and
5 is in words and figures as follows, to-wit:

1 “Joint resolution proposing to amend article one (1) of
2 the constitution of Iowa by adding thereto a provision prohibiting
3 the manufacture, sale, or keeping for sale, of intoxicating liquors,
4 as a beverage, within this state.

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 That the following amendment to article one (1) of
2 the constitution of the state of Iowa be and the same is hereby
3 proposed: To add thereto following section twenty-six (26) thereof
4 and as section twenty-seven (27) of article one (1) of said
5 constitution the following, to-wit:

1 ‘Sec. 27. The manufacture, sale, or keeping for sale,
2 as a beverage, of intoxicating liquors, including ale, wine and
3 beer, shall be forever prohibited within this state. The general
4 assembly shall by law prescribe regulations for the enforcement
5 of the prohibition herein contained, and shall provide
6 suitable penalties for the violation of the provisions hereof.’

1 *Resolved, further, that the foregoing proposed amendment*
2 *be and the same is hereby referred to the legislature to be*
3 *chosen at the next general election for members of the next*
4 *general assembly, and that the secretary of state cause the same*
5 *to be published for three months previous to the day of said*
6 *election, as provided by law.”*

1 be and the same is hereby agreed to, enacted and adopted.
