A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend the law as it appears in section 5077-c, supplement to the code of Iowa, 1913, providing for the regulation of solicitors of financial aid from the public, and to provide for the punishment for violation thereof.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. That the law as it appears in section
2 5077-c, supplement to the code of Iowa, 1913, be amended
3 by striking out the period in line 14, and inserting a
4 comma, and adding after the comma the following: "and
5 all persons before soliciting financial or other aid
6 from the public for themselves or for others, outside the
7 municipality in which such persons so soliciting re-
8 side, shall procure from the mayor and city council,
9 if the municipality of his residence be a city a city or town,
10 and from the township clerk if the municipality be a
11 township, a certificate which shall contain a statement
12 of the name, age, and residence of the solicitor, and
13 that such solicitor intends to ask public aid for the
14 purpose set forth in such certificate, and such cer-
15 tificate shall contain a general statement as to whether
16 the objects for which aid is sought are worthy, and
17 whether the solicitor is reputable and can be relied
18 upon to use the funds for aid so solicited for the pur-

19 poses he represents they will be used.”

1 Sec. 2. That section 5077-c be further
2 amended by striking out of line fifteen thereof the
3 word “person”, and out of line sixteen the first
4 word of said line, and by striking out of line
5 eighteen the words “such person resides or”.

1 Sec. 3. That section 5077-d, of the supple-
2 ment to the code, 1913, be amended by inserting after
3 the word “license” in line three thereof, the following
4 “or certificate”.
