A BILL FOR AN ACT

To legalize the title to certain buildings now located upon the grounds of the Iowa State Penitentiary, Fort Madison, Lee County, Iowa.

Whereas, existing under and by authority of the officials of the state of Iowa, the Iowa Farming Tool Company many years ago erected upon land belonging to the state of Iowa at the state penitentiary at Fort Madison, Iowa, said land being outside of the walls of the penitentiary, certain buildings to be used by the Iowa Farming Tool Company in connection with their business and their contract with the state of Iowa; and,

Whereas, the said buildings were erected by the said Iowa Farming Tool Company under an oral agreement with the officials of the state, providing that the ownership of the buildings should remain in the Iowa Farming Tool Company; and,

Whereas, the contract existing between the state of Iowa and the Iowa Farming Tool Company is now terminated and it is the desire of the Iowa Farming Tool Company to remove the said buildings from the ground belonging to the state of Iowa onto adjacent ground belonging to the Iowa Farming Tool Company; therefore,

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. That the title to the said buildings
2 and the ownership thereof, be and the same is hereby
3 declared to be in the Iowa Farming Tool Company.

1 Sec. 2. This act being deemed of immediate im-
2 portance, it shall take effect from and after its publi-
3 cation in one issue each of the Des Moines Register and

4 the Fort Madison Evening Democrat, newspapers published
5 in the cities of Des Moines and Fort Madison respectively,
6 said publication to be without expense to the state.
