

A BILL FOR

An act to legalize the official acts of Laura Smith Day, of Wapello County, Iowa, as notary public.

Whereas, Laura Smith of Blakesburg, Wapello County, Iowa, was duly commissioned as a notary public on the fifth (5) day of July, 1921 and continued to act as a notary public and take acknowledgments and sign certificates as Laura Smith until the twenty-fifth (25th) day of January, 1924, and

Whereas, the said Laura Smith was married on the twenty-fifth (25th) day of September, 1923, and that by reason of the said marriage, her legal name became Laura Smith Day, and

Whereas, the said Laura Smith Day was commissioned as a notary public under her correct name on the twenty-fifth (25th) day of January, 1924.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. That all acknowledgments of written
2 instruments including affidavits, deeds, mortgages and all
3 other documents taken or made by the said Laura Smith Day
4 after her marriage on the twenty-fifth (25th) day of
5 September 1923 down to and including the twenty-fifth
6 (25th) day of January, 1924 as Laura Smith, be and the same
7 are hereby legalized and made valid the same as though the
8 said Laura Smith Day had been duly commissioned as a
9 notary public under that name at the time such acknowledg-
10 ments were taken, provided nothing in this act shall affect
11 pending litigation.

1 Sec. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance

2 shall be in force and effect from and after its publication
3 in the Blakesburg Excelsior, a newspaper published at
4 Blakesburg, Iowa, and the Iowa Forum, a newspaper published
5 at Des Moines, Iowa.
