A BILL FOR

An Act to amend, revise, and codify sections eleven thousand six hundred three (11603), eleven thousand six hundred four (11604), and eleven thousand six hundred five (11605) of the Code, 1927, relating to the lien of judgments of the State and Federal Courts.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Sections eleven thousand six hundred three (11603)
2 eleven thousand six hundred four (11604), and eleven thousand six
3 hundred five (11605) of the Code, 1927, are amended, revised, and
4 codified to read as follows:

5 "11603. When judgment lien attaches. When the land lies in
6 the county where in the judgment of the district court of this
7 state or of the circuit or district courts of the United States
8 was rendered, the lien shall attach from the date of such rendition,
9 but if in another it will not attach until an attested copy of the
10 judgment is filed in the office of the clerk of the district court
11 of the county in which the land lies.

12 11604. Supreme court judgments. The lien of judgments of the
13 supreme court of Iowa shall not attach to any real estate until an
14 attested copy of the judgment is filed in the office of the clerk of
15 the county in which the land lies.

16 11605. Docketing transcript. Such clerk shall, on the filing
17 of such transcript of the judgment of the supreme or district court
18 of this state or of the circuit or district court of the United

19 States in his office, immediately proceed to docket and index the
20 same, in the same manner as though rendered in the court of his
21 own county.

1 Sec. 2. Publication clause. This act is deemed of im-
2 mediate importance and shall take effect from and after its pub-
3 lication in two (2) newspapers of this state as provided by law.
