## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the law as it appears in sections nine hundred five (905) and nine hundred six (906) of the code, 1924, relating to the purchase of voting machines.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section nine hundred five (905) of the  
2 code, 1924, is hereby amended by inserting preceding the comma  
3 (,) following the word "may" in line three (3) of said section  
4 the following: "submit a detailed statement showing the number  
5 of voting machines required, the total cost of same, the amount  
6 of annual tax required to be levied to retire bonds or certifi-  
7 cates issued in anticipation of funds required to purchase, and  
8 the total vote cast in each precinct at the last preceding pres-  
9 idential election. If satisfied that the use of voting machines  
10 will be conducive to economy and expediency, the director of the  
11 budget may approve the proposition and the board of supervisors  
12 of the county, or the council of the city or town may,".

13 Said section nine hundred five (905) of the code, 1924,  
14 is further amended by changing the period at the end of said  
15 section to a comma and adding thereafter the words, "notwithstand-  
16 ing any provisions to the contrary in section fifty-two hundred  
17 fifty-eight (5258) of the code.

1 Sec. 2. Section nine hundred six (906) of the code,  
2 1924, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

3     “At or before the time such bonds or certificates are  
4     issued, the governing board shall provide for a tax levy suffie-  
5     ient to pay the principal and interest thereof as same become due.”
