## A BILL FOR

An Act to legalize a Special Election held on the tenth day of August, 1927, in the City of Tama, Iowa, whereat there was duly submitted to the voters for their approval, Ordinance No. 166, of the Ordinances of the City of Tama, Iowa, being an ordinance granting to the Iowa Railway and Light Corporation, an electric light and power franchise; and to legalize all acts and proceedings in respect to said election.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Tama, Iowa, did on the 12th day of July, 1927, unanimously pass and adopt Ordinance No. 166, of the Ordinances of the City of Tama, Iowa, same being an ordinance entitled "An ordinance granting the right of way to the Iowa Railway and Light Corporation, its successors and assigns, to erect, construct, maintain and operate the necessary fixtures and apparatus to supply electric light and power to the City of Tama, Iowa, and the inhabitants thereof, and prescribing the penalty for the violation of this ordinance; and to repeal all ordinances in conflict therewith;" and

Whereas, a special election was held in the City of Tama, Iowa, on the 10th day of August, 1927, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City of Tama, Iowa, for their approval, said ordinance, at which election there was cast 306 affirmative votes for the approval of the ordinance as submitted, and 28 negative votes against the ordinance as submitted, and

Whereas, doubt has arisen as to whether or not the ballots voted at said election sufficiently contained in full the ordinance as provided by statute; now, therefore,

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Special election. That the special
- 2 election held in the City of Tama, in the County of Tama,
- 3 and State of Iowa, on the 10th day of August, 1927, where-
- 4 at there was submitted to the voters, the proposition of
- 5 approving Ordinance No. 166, of the Ordinances of the City
- 6 of Tama, Iowa, granting to the Iowa Railway and Light

7 Corporation, a franchise to furnish light and power to the  
8 City of Tama, Iowa, and its inhabitants, and all acts,  
9 matters and things done in passing the ordinance, giving  
10 notice of election, form of ballots and the holding of  
11 said election, be, and the same are hereby declared to be  
12 legal and valid, notwithstanding any defects, omissions  
13 or irregularities in connection therewith, and that it be,  
14 and it is hereby declared that the vote at said election,  
15 duly and legally approved said Ordinance No. 166, of the Ordi-  
16 nances of the City of Tama, Iowa, being an ordinance  
17 entitled, "An ordinance granting the right of way to the  
18 Iowa Railway and Light Corporation, its successors and  
19 assigns, to erect, construct, maintain and operate the  
20 necessary fixtures and apparatus to supply electric light  
21 and power to the City of Tama, Iowa, and the inhabitants  
22 thereof, and prescribing the penalty for the violation of  
23 this ordinance; and to repeal all ordinances in conflict  
24 therewith," the same as though the law had in all respects  
25 been complied with.

1 Sec. 2. Publication. This act being deemed  
2 of immediate importance shall take effect and be in  
3 force from and after its publication in the Des Moines  
4 Register, a newspaper published at Des Moines, Iowa,  
5 and in the Tama News-Herald, a newspaper published at  
6 Tama, Iowa, all without expense to the State of Iowa.
