## A BILL FOR

An Act making an appropriation for the payment of typewriter rental, fees of legislative chaplains and other expenses of the general assembly.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds in  
2 the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the following sums,  
3 or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay the claims and  
4 expenses indicated.

1 Sec. 2. To the several typewriter agencies for rental of  
2 machines for the general assembly a sum equal to ten dollars  
3 (\$10.00) for each machine of standard size and twelve dollars  
4 (\$12.00) for each machine larger than standard size for the  
5 period of the session.

1 Sec. 3. To the several ministers of the state for their  
2 services as chaplains of the Senate and House of Representatives  
3 of the forty-third general assembly, the sum of five dollars  
4 (\$5.00) for each such service.

1 Sec. 4. To the Des Moines Rubber Stamp Works, Des Moines,  
2 Iowa, for badges for the general assembly, the sum of fifty-  
3 two dollars fifteen cents (\$52.15).

1 Sec. 5. To S. Davidson & Brothers, Des Moines, Iowa, for one  
2 chair each for the president of the Senate and the speaker of  
3 the House, the sum of two hundred thirty dollars and twenty cents  
4 (\$230.20).

1     Sec. 6. In addition to the amount provided for in Chapter  
2 4, Acts of the Special Session of the 42nd General Assembly,  
3 there is hereby appropriated the sum of seven hundred fifty  
4 dollars (\$750.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary for  
5 the purpose of carrying out provisions of said chapter.

1     Sec. 7. To The Fred R. Shaw Flower Shop, Council Bluffs,  
2 Iowa, for spray purchased for the funeral of Lieutenant Governor  
3 Kimball, the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00).

1     Sec. 8. To Don D. Donnan, Sergeant at Arms of the Senate,  
2 and Oley Nelson, Sergeant at Arms of the House, for coats for  
3 pages, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

1     Sec. 9. To reimburse the Executive Council for payment of  
2 expense of Senator J. R. Frailey in attending the funeral of  
3 Lieutenant Governor Kimball, the sum of forty-four dollars and  
4 seventeen cents (\$44.17).

1     Sec. 10. To Howard A. Mathews, for expense in attending the  
2 funeral of Lieutenant Governor Kimball, the sum of twenty-four  
3 dollars and fifty-four cents (\$24.54).

1     Sec. 11. To Senator B. M. Stoddard, for expense in  
2 attending the funeral of Lieutenant Governor Kimball, the  
3 sum of five dollars forty cents (\$5.40).

1     Sec. 12. To Senator J. G. Merritt, for expense in  
2 attending the funeral of Senator A. J. Shinn, the sum of  
3 four dollars fifteen cents (\$4.15).

1     Sec. 13. To Senator C. D. Booth, for expense in attending  
2 the funeral of Lieutenant Governor Kimball, the sum of five  
3 dollars eighty-six cents (\$5.86).

1     Sec. 14. To Senator C. D. Booth, for expense in attending  
2 the funeral of Senator A. J. Shinn, the sum of three dollars  
3 thirty-four cents (\$3.34).

1     Sec. 15. To W. T. Frame, in addition to salary otherwise  
2 provided, the sum of two dollars (\$2.00) per day for each day  
3 of the session of the Forty-third General Assembly.

1     Sec. 16. To Senators J. O. Shaff, twenty-one dollars seventy-  
2 two cents (\$21.72); H. B. Carroll, nineteen dollars forty-one  
3 cents (\$19.41); L. H. Doran, twelve dollars (\$12.00); F. C.  
4 Gilchrist, thirty-three dollars thirty-seven cents (\$33.37);  
5 Geo. M. Clearman, twenty dollars sixty-one cents (\$20.61); Chas.  
6 T. Rogers, nineteen dollars ninety-five cents (\$19.95), for  
7 expense visiting State Institutions as provided in Senate Con-  
8 current Resolution No. 9.

1     Sec. 17. To Representatives D. M. Griswold, fourteen dollars  
2 forty-seven cents (\$14.47); Ralph R. Hunt, nineteen dollars  
3 twenty cents (\$19.20); W. Walter Wilson, twelve dollars ninety-  
4 seven cents (\$12.97); Benj. Jaycox, nine dollars five cents  
5 (\$9.05); Fred W. Nelson, eleven dollars ninety-two cents (\$11.92);  
6 C. H. Nelson, ten dollars fifty-six cents (\$10.56); Frank C.  
7 Byers, five dollars eighty-five cents (\$5.85); Homer Hush, fourteen  
8 dollars seven cents (\$14.07); G. W. Smith, two dollars five cents  
9 (\$2.05), for expense visiting State Institutions as provided in  
10 Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 9.

1     Sec. 18. The auditor of state is hereby authorized and  
2 directed to pay the sums herein appropriated upon the

3 certification of the president and secretary of the Senate  
4 for Senate expense and the speaker and chief clerk of the  
5 House for House expense.

1 Sec. 19. This act being deemed of immediate importance  
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication  
3 in the Sioux City Journal, a newspaper published at Sioux City,  
4 Iowa, and the Anthon Herald, a newspaper published at Anthon,  
5 Iowa.
