

A BILL FOR

An Act to legalize and validate the acts, franchises, rights, privileges and corporate existence of corporations organized or purporting to have been organized under the laws of this State, in all cases wherein such a corporation has failed to file articles of incorporation or other instrument of similar import with the Secretary of State or otherwise to comply with the law relating to the organization of corporations, and/or to renew its corporate existence within the period limited by law, and has heretofore filed in the office of the Secretary of State its renewal articles of incorporation and a certificate of the adoption thereof and received from the Secretary of State a certificate of renewal.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. In all cases wherein a corporation organized
2 or purporting to have been organized under the laws of this State
3 has adopted articles of incorporation, or other instrument of
4 similar import, and has functioned as a corporation in carrying
5 out the objects and purposes set forth therein and in the trans-
6 action of its business, but has failed to file its articles of
7 incorporation or such other instrument with the Secretary of State,
8 and/or otherwise to comply with the laws of this State relating to
9 the organization of corporations, and/or to take appropriate action
10 for the renewal of its existence within the period limited by law,
11 and has subsequent thereto filed in the office of the Secretary of
12 State its renewal articles of incorporation and a certificate of
13 the adoption thereof, paid all fees in connection therewith and
14 has heretofore received a certificate from the Secretary of State

15 renewing and extending its corporate existence, the acts,
16 franchises, rights, privileges and corporate existence of
17 any such corporation are hereby legalized and validated and
18 shall have the same force and effect as if all the provisions
19 of the laws of this State relating to the organization of cor-
20 porations and the renewal of their corporate existence had been
21 strictly complied with.

1 Sec. 2. Nothing in this Act shall affect pending
2 litigation.

1 Sec. 3. This Act being deemed of immediate import-
2 ance shall be in force from and after its publication in the
3 Schleswig Leader, a newspaper published in Schleswig,
4 Iowa, and the Mapleton Press, a newspaper publish-
5 ed in Mapleton, Iowa, without expense to the State.
