A BILL FOR

An Act to amend Sections Forty-nine hundred sixty-d five (4960-d5), Forty-nine hundred sixty-d ten (4960-d10), Forty-nine hundred sixty-d twenty-nine (4960-d29), and Forty-nine hundred sixty-d forty-five (4960-d45), Code, 1931; and to repeal Sections Forty-nine hundred sixty-d eleven (4960-d11) and Five thousand twenty-five (5025) Code, 1931, relating to operators' and chauffeurs' license law.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. That Section Forty-nine hundred
2 sixty-d five (4960-d5), Code, 1931, is amended by
3 striking the word "fifteen" in lines three (3)
4 and six (6), respectively, and inserting in lieu
5 thereof the word "eighteen (18)"; also, by adding
6 following the word "school" in the seventh line
7 the following: "or when accompanied by a person of
8 not less than eighteen (18) years of age who has
9 an operator's license".

1 Sec. 2. That Section Forty-nine hundred sixty
2 -d ten (4960-d10), Code, 1931, is amended by strik-
3 ing the word "sixteen" in line four, and inserting
4 in lieu thereof the word "eighteen (18)".

1 Sec. 3. That Section Forty-nine hundred
2 sixty-d eleven (4960-d11), Code, 1931, is hereby
3 repealed.

1 Sec. 4. That Section Forty-nine hundred

2 sixty-d twenty-nine (4960-d29), Code, 1931,
3 be amended by striking all of the section follow-
4 ing the word “demand” in line four.

1 Sec. 5. That Section Forty-nine hundred
2 sixty-d forty-five (4960-d45), Code, 1931, is
3 amended by adding following the “period (.)” in
4 line five, the following: “Upon revocation of
5 the operator’s or chauffeur’s license of any
6 person under Section forty-nine sixty-d thirty-
7 three (4960-d33), Code, 1931, the person may
8 after six months from date of revocation make
9 application to the Department for the issuance
10 of a new license, provided that such application
11 shall be accompanied by recommendation for the
12 issuance of a new license signed by the judge pre-
13 siding at the time of conviction or plea of guilty,
14 the county attorney, and the sheriff of the county
15 in which such charges are filed. Upon receipt of
16 such application the Department may if it considers
17 it proper, issue new license under such restrictions
18 as it may see fit”.

1 Sec. 6. That Section Five thousand twenty-
2 five (5025), Code, 1931, is hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 7. This act being deemed of immediate
2 importance shall be in full force and effect
3 after its passage and publication in the
