A BILL FOR

An Act to enable the State of Iowa to secure the benefit of funds allotted to this State by the Federal Government for street and highway work, to authorize the state highway commission to cooperate with the Federal Government in the expenditure of such funds, and to provide a means for making prompt payment on such work.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Where funds have been allotted or appropriated
2 or may hereafter be allotted or appropriated by the Government
3 of the United States for the improvement of streets and
4 highways in this state, and the Federal statutes or the rules
5 and regulations of the Federal Government provide or contemplate
6 that such work shall be under the supervision of the State
7 Highway Commission, said Commission is hereby authorized and
8 empowered to let the necessary contracts for such construction
9 work, to supervise and direct such construction work, to comply
10 with the Federal statutes, rules and regulations, and to
11 cooperate with the Federal Government in the expenditure of
12 said Federal funds.

13 In order to avoid delays payment for such street
14 and highway projects or improvements constructed in cooperation
15 with the Federal Government may be advanced from the primary
16 road fund. When payments on said projects or improvements
17 are received by the State from the Federal Government, the
18 funds so received shall be credited to the primary road fund.

1 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance,
2 shall take effect on its publication in the Atlantic News
3 Telegraph, Atlantic, Iowa, and the Argus Herald, Sidney,
4 Iowa.
