County Officers
Provision

A BILL FOR

An Act so to amend chapter two hundred sixty-one (261), Code, 1931, and various sections of said chapter, as to eliminate certain unnecessary allowances to county officers as salary in counties which now or hereafter have a population of less than sixty thousand (60,000) and which now or hereafter may have two county seats at each of which district court is regularly held, and to fix in such counties the salary of certain county officers and of the first or chief deputy of each of said officers.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section fifty-two hundred twenty (5220), Code,
2 1931, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By striking out the first seven (7) lines of paragraph
4 twelve (12).

5 2. By inserting after the word "counties" in line eight (8)
6 of paragraph twelve (12) the following words, to wit: "having a
7 population of sixty thousand (60,000) or over."

1 Sec. 2. Section fifty-two hundred twenty-two (5222), Code,
2 1931, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By striking out paragraph twelve (12).

4 2. By inserting after the word "counties" in line fifteen
5 (15) of paragraph thirteen (13) the following words, to wit:
6 "having a population of sixty thousand (60,000) or over".

1 Sec. 3. Section fifty-two hundred twenty-four (5224), Code,
2 1931, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "county" in
3 line twenty-six (26) the following words, to wit: "having a popu-
4 lation of sixty thousand (60,000) or over".

1 Sec. 4. Section fifty-two hundred twenty-six (5226), Code,
2 1931, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “county” in
3 line one (1) of paragraph eleven (11) the following words, to
4 wit: “having a population of sixty thousand (60,000) or over”.

1 Sec. 5. Section fifty-two hundred twenty-seven (5227), Code,
2 1931, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By striking from lines four (4) and five (5) the words,
4 “and in any county where district court is held in but one place,”.

5 2. By inserting after the word “county” in line one (1) of
6 paragraph three (3) the following words, to wit: “having a popu-
7 lation of sixty thousand (60,000) or over”.

1 Sec. 6. Section fifty-two hundred twenty-eight (5228), Code,
2 1931, is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the word
3 “county” in line forty-four (44) the following words, to wit:
4 “having a population of sixty thousand (60,000) or over”.

1 Sec. 7. Section fifty-two hundred thirty (5230), Code, 1931.
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word “county” in line
3 one (1) of paragraph twelve (12) the following words, to wit:
4 “having a population of sixty thousand (60,000) or over”.

1 Sec. 8. Section fifty-two hundred thirty-one (5231), Code,
2 1931, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “county” in
3 line thirty-one (31) the following words, to wit: “having a
4 population of sixty thousand (60,000) or over”.

1 Sec. 9. Section fifty-two hundred thirty-six (5236), Code,
2 1931, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “county” in
3 line one (1) the following words, to wit: “having a population

4 of sixty thousand (60,000) or over”.

1 Sec. 10. Chapter two hundred sixty-one (261), Code, 1931,
2 is further amended by adding thereto the following, to wit:

3 “In counties now or hereafter having a population of less
4 than sixty thousand (60,000) and having two county seats at each
5 of which district court is regularly held, the annual salary of the
6 following county officers and of the first or chief deputy of each
7 such officer shall be as follows:

8 County Auditor and first or chief deputy, twenty-one hundred
9 fifty dollars (\$2150) each.

10 County Treasurer and first or chief deputy, twenty-one hundred
11 fifty dollars (\$2150) each.

12 County Recorder and first or chief deputy, eighteen hundred
13 fifty dollars (\$1850) each.

14 County Sheriff and first or chief deputy, nineteen hundred
15 dollars (\$1900) each.

16 County Attorney and first or chief assistant, sixteen hundred
17 dollars (\$1600) each.

18 Clerk of District Court and first or chief deputy, twenty-
19 one hundred fifty dollars (\$2150) each.”
