A BILL FOR

Drainage
of
the State

An Act to amend section seventy-five hundred ninety-C one (7590-C1), Code, 1931, relating to the purchases of tax sales certificates in drainage districts.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. That section seventy-five hundred ninety-C
2 one (7590-C1), Code, 1931, be and the same is hereby amended
3 by adding thereto the following:
4 "In any event where upon the request of the holder of any
5 bond or bonds issued by any drainage district the board of
6 supervisors shall fail, neglect or refuse to purchase the cer-
7 tificate of sale issued by the county treasurer and referred to
8 in this section in manner and form as permitted by this section,
9 the holder of such bond or bonds may upon filing with the county
10 auditor a sworn statement as to the making of such written request
11 upon the board of supervisors and a recital of the failure of
12 such board to act in the premises by complying with the provi-
13 sions of this section in the same manner and form purchase such
14 certificate and the ownership thereof shall thereupon vest in such
15 holder of such bond or bonds in trust for said drainage district
16 or sub-district, provided, however, that the holder shall have a
17 lien upon said certificate and any beneficial interest arising
18 therefrom for his actual outlays including his reasonable ex-
19 penses and attorney's fees, if any, incurred in the premises. In

20 the event any such holder of any bond or bonds shall acquire title
21 he shall have a right to lease or convey said premises, upon
22 giving thirty (30) days written notice to the board of super-
23 visors by filing the same with the county auditor and in the event
24 said board shall not approve said lease or sale, the same shall
25 be referred to the district court of the county where the
26 land is situated and there tried and determined in the
27 manner prescribed in section seventy-five hundred ninety-C
28 one (7590-C1), Code, 1931. Any funds realized from the
29 lease or sale of said land shall be first applied in ex-
30 tinguishing the lien of the holder of the certificates herein
31 provided for and the balance shall be paid to the said
32 drainage bond fund of said district.”

1 Sec. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall take effect and be in force from and after its pub-
3 lication in The Daily Times and The Davenport Democrat,
4 newspapers published at Davenport, Iowa.
