A BILL FOR

An Act to make an appropriation for the State

Department of Social Welfare for its expenses and for aid to the needy blind, aid to dependent children and for the division of child welfare.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds
 2 in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for each
 3 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1937, and ending June 30,
 4 1939, the sum of one million four hundred fifty-three thousand
 5 (1,453,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
 6 to be used in the following manner:

7 STATE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE

8 For salaries, support, maintenance and miscel-
 9 laneous purposes\$ 40,000.00

10 AID FOR THE NEEDY BLIND

11 For salaries, support, maintenance and miscel-
 12 laneous purposes\$ 110,000.00

13 AID TO DEPENDENT CHILDREN

14 For salaries, support, maintenance and miscel-
 15 laneous purposes\$1,300,000.00

DIVISION OF CHILD WELFARE

16
17 For salaries, support, maintenance and miscel-
18 laneous purposes\$ 3,000.00

1 Sec. 2. Upon orders by the State Department of Social
2 Welfare, the comptroller shall draw warrants from the funds
3 herein appropriated, if he so approves, for the purposes herein
4 described.
