A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to Brown & Son, Cedar Falls, Iowa; Foster's Funeral Home, Webster City, Iowa; Larkin-Knutson, New Hampton, Iowa; W. H. Longnecker, Eldora, Iowa; R. W. Mansfield, Malvern, Iowa; Frank H. Raynor, Glenwood, Iowa; Carl G. Schultz, Monona, Iowa; Thomas Funeral Service, Carlisle, Iowa; Joe Gantz, Sioux City, Iowa; P. E. Kehoe, Farley, Iowa; and Bessie K. Regel, Charles City, Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age
 2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa to Brown & Son, Cedar Falls,
 3 Iowa, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in full payment of
 4 all claims they may have against the state of Iowa on account of
 5 funeral expenses for burial of Minnie Augutta, deceased recipient
 6 of old age assistance, rendered on or about August 4, 1936.

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age
 2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa to Foster's Funeral Home,
 3 Webster City, Iowa, the sum of forty-six dollars (\$46.00) in full
 4 payment of all claims it may have against the state of Iowa, on
 5 account of funeral expenses for burial of Susan Ann Butte, deceased
 6 recipient of old age assistance, rendered on or about June 27, 1937.

1 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age

2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa to Larkin-Knutson, New Hampton,
3 Iowa, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in full payment of
4 all claims they may have against the state of Iowa on account of
5 funeral expenses for burial of William Porter, deceased recipient
6 of old age assistance, rendered on or about March 25, 1937.

1 Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age
2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa to W. H. Longnecker, Eldora,
3 Iowa, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in full payment of
4 all claims he may have against the state of Iowa, on account of
5 funeral expenses for burial of Charles T. Caster, deceased recip-
6 ient of old age assistance, rendered on or about January 10, 1938.

1 Sec. 5. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age
2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa to R. W. Mansfield, Malvern,
3 Iowa, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in full payment of
4 all claims he may have against the state of Iowa, on account of
5 funeral expenses for burial of William Shepard, cancelled deceased
6 recipient of old age assistance, rendered on or about January
7 15, 1937.

1 Sec. 6. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age
2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa to Frank H. Raynor, Glenwood,
3 Iowa, the sum of sixty dollars (\$60.00) in full payment of all
4 claims he may have against the state of Iowa, on account of funeral
5 expenses for burial of Ruth Caroline Young, deceased recipient of
6 old age assistance, rendered on or about November 7, 1937.

1 Sec. 7. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age
2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa to Carl G. Schultz, Monona,

3 Iowa, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in full payment of
4 all claims he may have against the state of Iowa, on account of
5 funeral expenses for burial of William Pettit, deceased recip-
6 ient of old age assistance, rendered on or about June 1, 1937.

1 Sec. 8. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age
2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa to Carl G. Schultz, Monona,
3 Iowa, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in full payment
4 of all claims he may have against the state of Iowa, on account
5 of funeral expenses for burial of Collista A. Perkins, deceased
6 recipient of old age assistance, rendered on or about February
7 19, 1938.

1 Sec. 9. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age
2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa to the Thomas Funeral
3 Service, Carlisle, Iowa, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00)
4 in full payment of all claims it may have against the state of
5 Iowa, on account of funeral expenses for burial of Robert Green,
6 deceased recipient of old age assistance, rendered on or about
7 September 22, 1937.

1 Sec. 10. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age
2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa to Joe Gantz, Sioux City,
3 Iowa, the sum of sixteen dollars, (\$16.00) in full payment of all
4 claims he may have against the state of Iowa, on account of
5 having cashed an old age assistance warrant in said amount, in
6 the usual course of business, upon which payment was stopped by
7 order of the state board of social welfare and the state comp-
8 troller.

1 Sec. 11. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age
2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa, to P. E. Kehoe, Farley,
3 Iowa, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) as a compromise
4 settlement and in full payment of all claims he may have against
5 the state of Iowa for services rendered as a part-time employee
6 in the tax section, division of old age assistance, of the state
7 board of social welfare, and expenses incurred, from September
8 8, 1936, to October 24, 1936, inclusive.

1 Sec. 12. There is hereby appropriated out of the old age
2 assistance fund of the state of Iowa to Bessie K. Regel, Charles
3 City, Iowa, the sum of forty-two dollars and ninety-one cents
4 (\$42.91) in full settlement of all claims she may have against
5 the state of Iowa, for services rendered as an investigator for
6 the state board of social welfare, in and for Floyd county, Iowa,
7 from September 27, 1935, to October 15, 1935, inclusive.

1 Sec. 13. The state comptroller is hereby directed to issue
2 his warrants to the above named parties in the amounts stated,
3 and the state treasurer is hereby directed to pay said warrants
4 upon presentation out of said fund.

1 Sec. 14. The acceptance of the said sums by the respective
2 parties shall be in full settlement of all claims against the
3 state of Iowa growing out of said items specifically referred to
4 in this act.
