A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to Hurwich Furniture Company,
Monona County Achievement Show, Cass County Farm Improve-
ment Association, C. B. Schager, M. W. Baier, Wm. M.
Whisler, David Swanson, J. O. Westrum and Dr. R. W. Jackson.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general
2 fund of the state the following:

3 To Hurwich Furniture Company, Waterloo, Iowa, the sum of
4 thirty-three dollars and forty-five cents (\$33.45) in full
5 settlement of all claims it may have against the state of Iowa
6 for furniture rented to the agricultural department of the
7 state during the 1937 Dairy Cattle Congress in Waterloo, Iowa
8 and which furniture was destroyed by fire.

9 To the Monona County Achievement Show, Monona county,
10 Iowa, the sum of two hundred eighty-three dollars and sixty-
11 eight cents (\$283.68) in full settlement of all claims it may
12 have against the state of Iowa under section two thousand nine
13 hundred twenty-three (2923), Code, 1935, for premiums paid at
14 the Short Course held during 1937 in Mapleton, Iowa.

15 To the Cass County Farm Improvement Association, Atlantic,
16 Iowa, the sum of four hundred ninety dollars (\$490.00) in full

17 settlement of all claims it may have against the state of Iowa
18 for expenses incurred by the Cass County 4-H Fair held in At-
19 lantic, Iowa, from August 17 to 20, 1938.

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the animal
2 industry fund of the state the following:

3 To C. B. Schager, Dows, Iowa, the sum of one thousand
4 eighty-five dollars (\$1,085.00) in full settlement of all
5 claims he may have against the state of Iowa for the destruc-
6 tion of nine horses on August 19, 1937, two horses on October
7 12, 1937 and one horse on April 14, 1938, all of which were infected
8 with glanders.

9 To M. W. Baier, Chapin, Iowa, the sum of one hundred
10 eighty-five dollars (\$185.00) in full settlement of all claims
11 he may have against the state of Iowa for the destruction of
12 two horses on November 13, 1937, which were infected with
13 glanders.

14 To Wm. M. Whisler, Alden, Iowa, the sum of one hundred
15 dollars (\$100.00) in full settlement of all claims he may have
16 against the state of Iowa for the destruction of one horse on
17 February 5, 1938, which was infected with glanders.

18 To David Swanson, Stratford, Iowa, the sum of one hundred
19 thirty-five dollars (\$135.00) in full settlement of all claims
20 he may have against the state of Iowa for the destruction of
21 two horses on October 18, 1937, which were infected with
22 glanders.

23 To J. O. Westrum, Stratford, Iowa, the sum of seventy-

24 five dollars (\$75.00) in full settlement of all claims he may
25 have against the state of Iowa for the destruction of a horse
26 on October 16, 1937, which was infected with glanders.

27 To Dr. R. W. Jackson, Kellerton, Iowa, the sum of twenty-
28 four dollars and fifty cents (\$24.50) in full settlement of
29 all claims he may have against the state of Iowa for profes-
30 sional services and expenses incident to a trip to the Anna
31 Martin farm at Shannon City, Iowa, on March 19, 1935, and to
32 the Holland farm at Redding, Iowa, on March 19, 1937.

1 Sec. 3. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to
2 issue his warrants to the above named parties in the amounts
3 stated and the treasurer of state is hereby directed to pay the
4 same from the general fund and from the animal industry fund
5 of the state, respectively.

1 Sec. 4. The acceptance of the said amounts by the above
2 named claimants shall be in full settlement of all claims
3 against the state of Iowa growing out of the above described
4 claims.
