A BILL FOR

An Act to amend Senate File three hundred seventy-nine (379), Acts of the 48th General Assembly, relating to the department of public safety of the State of Iowa, transferring the supervision of registration of motor vehicles and the enforcement of motor vehicle law to said department, and providing that the funds heretofore appropriated be made available to the department of public safety on the effective date of this act.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two (2) of Senate File three hundred
2 seventy-nine (379), Acts of the 48th General Assembly, is
3 hereby amended by striking the word "sixth" appearing in line
4 three (3) of said section in the enrolled act, and substi-
5 tuting in lieu thereof the word "fourth".

1 Sec. 2. Section thirty-two (32) of Senate File three
2 hundred seventy-nine (379), Acts of the 48th General Assembly,
3 is hereby amended by striking all of lines four (4) to ten
4 (10) inclusive of said section in the enrolled act and in-
5 serting in lieu thereof the following:

6 "30. Commissioner means the commissioner of public
7 safety of the state."

1 Sec. 3. Section thirty-three (33), of Senate File three
2 hundred seventy-nine (379), Acts of the 48th General Assembly,
3 is hereby amended by striking all of lines four (4) to ten (10),
4 inclusive, of said section in the enrolled act, and inserting
5 in lieu thereof the following:

6 “31. Department means the department of public safety
7 of the state.”

1 Sec. 4. Section ninety-five (95) of Senate File three
2 hundred seventy-nine (379), Acts of the 48th General Assembly,
3 is hereby amended by adding after the period (.) in the last
4 line of said section the following:

5 “But the Commissioner of public safety shall, upon the
6 requisition of the attorney general, from time to time assign
7 for service in the department of justice such of its officers,
8 not to exceed six in number, as may be requisitioned by the
9 attorney general for special service in the department of
10 justice, and when so assigned such officers shall be under
11 the exclusive direction and control of the attorney general.”

1 Sec. 5. Senate File three hundred seventy-nine (379),
2 Acts of the 48th General Assembly, is hereby amended by add-
3 ing thereto the following section:

4 “The unexpired balance in the three per cent maintenance
5 fund for the motor vehicle department provided for in section
6 one hundred seventy-five (175) of chapter one hundred thirty-
7 four (134), Acts of the 47th General Assembly, and the un-
8 expended balance in the maintenance fund from operator’s and

9 chauffeur's licenses, provided for in section two hundred
10 twenty-three (223) of said act, are hereby transferred to the
11 general fund of the state."

1 Sec. 6. Senate File three hundred seventy-nine (379),
2 Acts of the 48th General Assembly, is hereby amended by
3 adding thereto the following section:

4 "The unused portion of the appropriations allocated to
5 the various departments consolidated by this act shall be,
6 upon the effective date of this act, transferred to the depart-
7 ment of safety for the purpose of maintaining said department
8 until June 30, 1939, and for the trust department so trans-
9 ferred there is hereby appropriated from any money in the
10 state treasury not otherwise appropriated, an amount suffi-
11 cient to pay salaries and other administration expenses to
12 June 30, 1939."

1 Sec. 7. Senate File three hundred seventy-nine (379),
2 Acts of the 48th General Assembly, is hereby amended by
3 inserting the following:

4 "Sections two (2) to twelve (12), inclusive, of chapter
5 one hundred thirty-four (134), Acts of the 47th General Assembly,
6 are hereby repealed."

1 Sec. 8. Senate File three hundred seventy-nine (379),
2 Acts of the 48th General Assembly, is hereby amended by insert-
3 ing the following:

4 "Section sixteen (16) of chapter one hundred thirty-four
5 (134), Acts of the 47th General Assembly, is hereby amended

6 by striking from lines one (1) to two (2) the words, 'Subject
7 to the approval of the secretary of state'."

1 Sec. 9. Senate File three hundred seventy-nine (379),
2 Acts of the 48th General Assembly, is hereby amended by insert-
3 ing the following:

4 "Section seventeen (17) of chapter one hundred thirty-four
5 (134), Acts of the 47th General Assembly, is hereby amended by
6 striking from lines one (1) and two (2) the words, 'Subject
7 to the approval of the secretary of state'."

1 Sec. 10. Senate File three hundred seventy-nine (379),
2 Acts of the 48th General Assembly, is hereby amended by insert-
3 ing the following:

4 "Section fifteen (15) of chapter one hundred thirty-four
5 (134), Acts of the 47th General Assembly, is hereby amended
6 by striking the last sentence thereof."

1 Sec. 11. Senate File three hundred seventy-nine (379),
2 Acts of the 48th General Assembly, is hereby amended by
3 inserting the following:

4 "Section nineteen (19) of chapter one hundred thirty-
5 four (134), Acts of the 47th General Assembly, is repealed
6 and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

7 '19. The department may adopt an official seal.'"

1 Sec. 12. This act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect after its publication in The
3 Menville Mail, a newspaper published at Menville, Iowa, and the
4 Clinton Herald, a newspaper published at Clinton, Iowa.
