A BILL FOR

An Act to repeal all of chapter three hundred eighteen (318), to repeal sections seven thousand one hundred twenty-five (7125) and six thousand eight hundred ninety-seven (6897), and to amend sections one thousand six hundred fifty-six (1656), five thousand nine hundred forty (5940), five thousand nine hundred fifty-one (5951), seven thousand one hundred ninety (7190), and seven thousand two hundred three (7203), Code, 1939, relating to the road poll tax in cities and towns.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter three hundred eighteen (318), Code, 1939,
2 is hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 2. Sections six thousand eight hundred ninety-seven
2 (6897) and seven thousand one hundred twenty-five (7125), Code,
3 1939, are hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 3. Section one thousand six hundred fifty-six (1656),
2 Code, 1939, is hereby amended by striking from lines seven (7) and
3 eight (8) the following: "and labor on the roads on account of poll
4 tax," and by striking all of line fifteen (15).

1 Sec. 4. Section five thousand nine hundred forty (5940), Code,
2 1939, is hereby amended by striking from line four (4) the words
3 "or poll".

1 Sec. 5. Section five thousand nine hundred fifty-one (5951),
2 Code, 1939, is hereby amended by striking from line six (6) the
3 words "or poll".

1 Sec. 6. Section seven thousand one hundred ninety (7190),
2 Code, 1939, is hereby amended by striking from lines six (6) and
3 seven (7) the words "and delinquent poll taxes".

1 Sec. 7. Section seven thousand two hundred three (7203),
2 Code, 1939, is hereby amended by striking from lines one (1) and
3 two (2) the words "poll taxes and" and from line sixteen (16) the
4 words "all poll taxes and to".

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 128

This bill intends to correct the situation equalizing the rural and city persons under the age of forty-five by exempting every person from poll tax. The persons residing in rural areas are already exempted.
