A BILL FOR

An Act to repeal Sections 3828.007, 3828.028 and 3828.029 and to amend Sections 3828.008, 3828.009, 3828.014 and 3828.042, Code, 1939, as amended by the Acts of the 49th General Assembly, all relating to old-age assistance; to the qualification and eligibility of recipients; to the matter of limiting and determining the amount of assistance and providing for transfers of funds from the old-age assistance revolving fund to the old-age assistance fund.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section 3828.007, Code, 1939, be and is
2 hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 2. Section 3828.008, Code, 1939, as amended by
2 Chapters 145 and 146 of the Acts of the 49th General Assembly,
3 is hereby amended by repealing sub-section six (6) and sub-
4 section eight (8) thereof and renumbering sub-sections seven
5 (7) and nine (9) in consecutive order, and by adding to sub-
6 section nine (9) the following: "and such person has no
7 additional needs."

1 Sec. 3. Section 3828.009, Code, 1939, as amended by
2 Chapter 146, Acts of the 49th General Assembly, is hereby
3 amended by striking from line ten (10) thereof the words

4 “twenty-five” and substituting therefor the word “forty”.

1 Sec. 4. Section 3828.014, Code, 1939, as amended by
2 Chapters 145 and 146, Acts of the 49th General Assembly, is
3 hereby amended by striking from line four (4) thereof the word
4 “sixty” and substituting therefor the word “thirty”; by
5 striking from line thirteen (13) thereof the word “ninety” and
6 substituting therefor the word “thirty”; by striking from line
7 twenty-nine (29) thereof the word “sixty” and substituting
8 therefor the word “thirty”; and by striking from line five
9 (5) of section six (6), chapter one hundred forty-six (146),
10 Acts of the 49th General Assembly the following: “ninety (90)”,
11 and by substituting therefor the word “thirty”.

1 Sec. 5. Section 3828.028, Code, 1939, as amended by
2 Chapter 145, be and is hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 6. Section 3828.029, Code, 1939, as amended by
2 Chapter 146, Acts of the 49th General Assembly, be and is
3 hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 7. Section 3828.042, Code, 1939, as amended by
2 Chap. 145, is hereby amended by striking all of said section
3 following the period (.) after the word “fund” in line 25 thereof
4 and by substituting therefor the following: “At the end of
5 each quarter of each fiscal year if the old-age assistance
6 revolving fund shall have a cash balance in excess of two
7 hundred thousand dollars, the state comptroller shall transfer
8 such excess to the old-age assistance fund and shall notify the
9 state board of such transfer. The amounts thus transferred

10 shall supplement other allocations to the old-age assistance fund
11 and may be expended for the purposes and in the manner referred
12 to in Section 3828.039.”

1 Sec. 8. Other provisions of chapter 189.1 of the 1939
2 Code of Iowa to the contrary notwithstanding, the state and
3 county welfare boards are hereby authorized and directed to
4 review as soon as practicable, the case reports of all old-
5 age assistance recipients for the purpose of determining
6 their present needs and adjusting assistance.

1 Sec. 9. This act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
3 and publication in The American Citizen, a newspaper
4 published at Des Moines, Iowa; and The Bremer County
5 Independent and Waverly Republican, published at Waverly,
6 Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 355

The purpose of this act is to liberalize the provisions of the statutes providing for old age assistance by raising the maximum amount of payments to \$40 and to provide for transfers of funds from the Old Age Revolving Fund to the Old Age Assistance Fund.
