A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to M. D. Synhorst, Orange City, Iowa; James Babcock, Drakesville, Iowa; Esther Deahl, Centerville, Iowa; Ben Brasser, Cherokee, Iowa; Dr. James McKenzie, Baxter, Iowa; M. W. Ellis, Receiver of the American Trust and Savings Bank, LeMars, Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of
2 the General Fund of the State of Iowa, to M. D. Synhorst,
3 Orange City, Iowa, the sum of \$150.00 in full settlement
4 of all claims which he may have against the State of Iowa,
5 for salary, by reason of his enlistment in the United
6 States Navy.

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 General Fund of the State of Iowa, to James Babcock,
3 Drakesville, Iowa, the sum of \$55.21, in full settlement
4 of all claims which he may have against the State of Iowa
5 for personal injury suffered by him while cranking a
6 gasoline engine on the 11th day of August, 1941, at Lake
7 Wapello State Park, of which he is custodian.

1 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 General Administrative Fund of the Social Welfare Department

3 of the State of Iowa to Esther Deahl, of Centerville, Iowa,
4 the sum of \$7.50, same to be in full settlement of all claims
5 which she may have against the State of Iowa, by reason of
6 expense incurred by her while acting as Director of Social
7 Welfare in Appanoose County.

1 Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 General Fund of the State of Iowa to Ben Brassler of
3 Cherokee, Iowa, the sum of \$555.00 in full settlement of
4 all claims which he may have against the State of Iowa
5 for legal fees accrued in his defense as a Highway Patrolman
6 on charge of false arrest, from which, upon trial, he was
7 acquitted.

1 Sec. 5. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 General Fund of the State of Iowa, to Dr. James McKenzie
3 of Baxter, Iowa, the sum of \$40.00 in full settlement
4 of all claims which he may have against the State of Iowa
5 for services performed by him for supervision of dipping
6 sheep affected with scabies.

1 Sec. 6. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 General Fund of the State of Iowa, to M. W. Ellis, Receiver
3 of the American Trust and Savings Bank of LeMars, Iowa,
4 the sum of \$714.55, being in full settlement of all claims
5 which he may have against the State of Iowa, by reason of
6 a note and interest on same, given by Company K, 133
7 Infantry, Iowa National Guard to the above named bank.

1 Sec. 7. The State Comptroller is hereby authorized

2 to issue warrants to the above named parties in the amounts
3 stated in the preceding sections, and the Treasurer is
4 hereby directed to pay the same from the General Fund of
5 the State of Iowa. The acceptance of said amounts by the
6 above named parties shall be in full settlements of all
7 claims against the State of Iowa, growing out of their
8 respective claims above described. .
