A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to the First National Bank of Council Bluffs, Iowa, Ray Butler, Arnolds Park, Iowa, LeFebure Corporation, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, Harry Jenkins, LaCrosse, Wisconsin, George F. Brown, Sioux City, Iowa, Paul Fellman, Davenport, Iowa, Earl Scherf and K. M. Rooker, Ottumwa, Iowa, Johnath Gauger, Boone, Iowa, City of Ames, Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 State Sinking Fund to the First National Bank of Council
3 Bluffs, Iowa, the sum of one hundred thirteen dollars
4 and thirty-four cents (\$113.34) in full settlement of
5 all claims it may have against the State of Iowa on account
6 of assessment overpaid to the State Sinking Fund.

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 funds of the State Conservation Commission to Ray Butler
3 of Arnolds Park, Iowa, the sum of fifteen hundred
4 dollars (\$1500.00) in full settlement of all claims he may
5 have against the State of Iowa, for loss of household
6 goods burned while being transported by State Conservation
7 truck on September 29, 1937.

1 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa to the LeFebure
3 Corporation of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, the sum of
4 one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1250.00)
5 in full settlement of all claims which said corporation may
6 have against the State of Iowa on account of materials
7 used in filling Executive Council Order Number three
8 thousand two hundred twenty-one (3221) for printing in
9 connection with renewing census records of the State of
10 Iowa.

1 Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa to Harry Jenkins of
3 LaCrosse, Wisconsin, the sum of eight dollars and
4 eighty-five cents (\$8.85) in full settlement of all
5 claims which he may have against the State of Iowa on
6 account of fine assessed against him, contrary to
7 reciprocal agreement between Wisconsin and Iowa
8 Motor Vehicle Departments.

1 Sec. 5. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa to George F. Brown
3 of Sioux City, Iowa, the sum of eighty dollars (\$80.00)
4 in full settlement of all claims which he may have
5 against the State of Iowa on account of an injury
6 received at the Cherokee State Hospital on March
7 16, 1941.

1 Sec. 6. There is hereby appropriated out of the

2 general fund of the State of Iowa to Paul Fellman of
3 Davenport, Iowa, the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00)
4 in full settlement of all claims which he may have
5 against the State of Iowa on account of injury received
6 by him while an inmate of the Fort Madison Penitentiary
7 on August 25, 1936.

1 Sec. 7. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 funds of the State Conservation Commission of the State
3 of Iowa to Earl Scherf and K. M. Rooker, Conservation
4 Commission Officers of Ottumwa, Iowa, the sum of
5 three hundred seventy-one dollars and fifty-five cents
6 (\$371.55) in full settlement of all claims they may have
7 against the State of Iowa for legal fees charged them
8 in connection with the defense of a charge of wrongful
9 arrest, from which they were acquitted, said three
10 hundred seventy-one dollars and fifty-five cents (\$371.55)
11 to be paid out as follows: To Wilbur Dull, one of the
12 attorneys for the above named parties the sum of
13 one hundred sixty-five dollars (\$165.00). To John D.
14 Moon, one of the attorneys for the above named parties,
15 the sum of two hundred one dollars and fifty-five
16 cents (\$201.55). To Arthur Dorothy, Court Reporter
17 for the above matter the sum of five dollars (\$5.00).

1 Sec. 8. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa to Johnath Gauger
3 the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) in full

4 settlement of all claims which he may have against the
5 State of Iowa on account of injuries received by him
6 while an inmate of the Anamosa Reformatory, on
7 August 20, 1940.

1 Sec. 9. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa to the City of
3 Ames, Iowa, the sum of two thousand three hundred ninety-
4 one dollars and nineteen cents (\$2391.19) in full
5 settlement of all claims which the city may have against
6 the state of Iowa for special assessments for curb and
7 gutter and stabilized gravel 1939A and special assessments
8 for curb and gutter and stabilized gravel 1938B, City
9 of Ames.

1 Sec. 10. The State Comptroller is hereby authorized
2 to issue his warrant to the above named parties in the
3 amounts stated, and the State Treasurer is hereby directed
4 to pay the same from the respective funds above specified.

1 Sec. 11. The acceptance of said sum by the above
2 named parties shall be in full settlement of all claims
3 against the State of Iowa growing out of the above
4 described claims.
