## A BILL FOR

An Act to legalize the corporate acts and proceedings in connection with the renewal of the corporate existence and the adoption of the amended and renewed articles of incorporation of Smith Brothers and Burdick Company and to provide for the renewal of the charter of said company.

WHEREAS, the period of the corporate existence of Smith Brothers & Burdick Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Iowa, with its principal place of business in the City of Davenport, Iowa, expired on the first day of September, 1938, and through inadvertence the same was not renewed within the period prescribed by statute, and

WHEREAS, Smith Brothers & Burdick Company has continued thereafter to conduct its business and affairs as a corporation, and

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of January, 1945, a special meeting of the stockholders was called and held for the purpose of extending and renewing the said corporation for a period of twenty years from September 1, 1938, and adopting the amended and renewed Articles of Incorporation, and

WHEREAS, Smith Brothers & Burdick Company has filed the said amended and renewed articles of incorporation, together with a certificate of renewal of the said Corporation, with the Secretary of State of the State of Iowa, and has paid the proper renewal fees and recording fees, and has in all other particulars complied with the provisions of the statutes relating to renewals of corporations, Now, Therefore,

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. All proceedings had with respect to the
- 2 renewal of the corporate existence of Smith Brothers & Burdick

3 Company, a corporation with its principal place of business in  
4 Davenport, Iowa, and all corporate acts of said corporation,  
5 its officers and stockholders, since the expiration of the  
6 corporate existence of said corporation on the 1st day of  
7 September, 1938, are hereby legalized and shall have the same  
8 force and effect as though the said proceedings had been adopted  
9 pursuant to law and within the period prescribed by the statute,  
10 and shall be held and considered as a renewal and extension of  
11 the period of the corporate existence of said corporation,  
12 which expired on September 1, 1938, and all corporate acts and  
13 proceedings of said corporation, including the proceedings in  
14 connection with the renewal and extension of said corporation  
15 and the adoption of the amended and renewed articles of incorpora-  
tion,  
16 are hereby declared to be valid and legal.

1 Sec. 2. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to acknowledge and file and record the certificate  
3 of renewal of said corporation previously delivered to him by  
4 said Corporation, and to issue a certificate of renewal to Smith  
5 Brothers & Burdick Company, said renewal to extend the corporate  
6 existence of said corporation for a period of twenty (20) years  
7 from September 1, 1938, which certificate of renewal shall have  
8 the same force and effect as though issued upon proper and  
9 timely application by said Corporation.

1 Sec. 3. Nothing in this act shall be deemed or con-  
2 strued to affect pending litigation, if any, involving said

3 corporation, or any claims outstanding against said corporation.

1     Sec. 4. This act, being deemed of immediate importance,  
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage  
3 and publication in the Daily Times and The Democrat and Leader,  
4 newspapers published in the City of Davenport, Iowa, without  
5 expense to the State of Iowa.
