A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to Woodrow H. Sherin, Des Moines, Iowa; Laurence K. Smith, Des Moines, Iowa; and K. Edward Johnson, Des Moines, Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa to Woodrow H. Sherin, Des
3 Moines, Iowa, the sum of two hundred sixteen dollars (\$216.00)
4 in full settlement of all claims which he may have against the
5 State of Iowa for salary due under section four hundred sixty-
6 seven and twenty-five hundredths (467.25), Code, 1939, as
7 amended by chapter seventy-three (73), Acts of the Forty-ninth
8 General Assembly, by reason of his induction in the United
9 States Army.

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa to Laurence K. Smith, Des
3 Moines, Iowa, the sum of two hundred seventy dollars (\$270.00)
4 in full settlement of all claims which he may have against the
5 State of Iowa for salary due under section four hundred sixty-
6 seven and twenty-five hundredths (467.25), Code, 1939, as
7 amended by chapter seventy-three (73), Acts of the Forty-ninth

8 General Assembly, by reason of his induction in the United
9 States Army.

1 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa, to K. Edward Johnson, Des
3 Moines, Iowa, the sum of two hundred seventy dollars (\$270.00)
4 in full settlement of all claims which he may have against the
5 State of Iowa for salary due under section four hundred sixty-
6 seven and twenty-five hundredths (467.25), Code, 1939, as
7 amended by chapter seventy-three (73), Acts of the Forty-ninth
8 General Assembly, by reason of his induction in the United
9 States Army.

1 Sec. 4. The State Comptroller is hereby authorized to
2 issue his warrant to the above named parties in the amounts
3 stated, and the State Treasurer is hereby directed to pay the
4 same from the respective funds above specified.

1 Sec. 5. The acceptance of said sum by the above named
2 parties shall be in full settlement of all claims against the
3 State of Iowa growing out of the above described claims.
