A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the law as it appears in Chapter one hundred sixty-four point one (164.1), Code 1946, relating to the control and eradication of Bangs disease.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Amend section one hundred sixty-four point one
2 (164.1) by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:
3 " 'Calfhood Vaccination' shall mean the vaccination of any calf
4 with calfhood vaccine between the age of four (4) months and
5 twelve (12) months, which calf shall have been officially
6 vaccinated according to the rules and regulations established
7 by the Secretary of Agriculture."

1 Sec. 2. Amend section one hundred sixty-four point five
2 (164.5) by adding at the end of said section the following
3 sentence: "All Cattle which have been officially calfhood
4 vaccinated shall be eligible for certificates which certificates
5 shall declare such cattle free of Bang's disease and shall
6 entitle the owners of such cattle to transport or sell such
7 Cattle any place in the state of Iowa."

1 Sec. 3. Amend chapter one hundred sixty-four by adding
2 at the end thereof the following section: "Reciprocity.

3 The Secretary of Agriculture of the state of Iowa is hereby
4 authorized and directed to enter into reciprocal agreements
5 with other states to the end that Cattle which are officially
6 calfhood vaccinated in the state of Iowa and other states may
7 be transported and sold in interstate commerce between the
8 state of Iowa and such other states which enter into reciprocal
9 agreements.”
