## A BILL FOR

An Act to legalize the corporate acts and proceedings in connection with the renewal of the corporate existence and the adoption of amended, substituted, and renewal articles of incorporation of Strand Baking Company, and to provide for the renewal of the charter of said company.

WHEREAS, The period of the corporate existence of the Strand Baking Company, a corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Iowa, with its principal place of business in the City of Marshalltown, Iowa, expired on the 31st day of July, 1944, and through inadvertence the same was not renewed within the period prescribed by statute, and

WHEREAS, the Strand Baking Company has continued thereafter to conduct its business and affairs as a corporation, and

WHEREAS, on the 29th day of January, 1949, a special meeting of the stockholders was called and held, with 100 per cent of the corporate stock being represented, for the purpose of extending and renewing the said corporation for a period of twenty years from the 31st day of July, 1944, and adopting the amended, substituted, and renewal articles of incorporation, and

WHEREAS, the Strand Baking Company has filed the said amended, substituted and renewal articles of incorporation, together with a certificate of renewal of such corporation, with the Secretary of State of the State of Iowa, and has paid the proper renewal fees and recording fees, and has in all other particulars complied with the provisions of the statutes relating to renewals of corporations, NOW, THEREFORE,

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. All proceedings had with respect to the  
2 renewal of the corporate existence of Strand Baking Company,  
3 a corporation with its principal place of business in Marshall-  
4 town, Iowa, and all corporate acts of said corporation, its  
5 officers and stockholders, since the expiration of the corpo-  
6 rate existence of said corporation on the 31st day of July,  
7 1944, are hereby legalized and shall have the same force and  
8 effect as though the said proceedings had been adopted pur-  
9 suant to law and within the period prescribed by the statute,  
10 and shall be held and considered as a renewal and extension  
11 of the period of the corporate existence of said corporation,  
12 which expired on the 31st day of July, 1944, and all corporate  
13 acts and proceedings of said corporation, including the pro-  
14 ceedings in connection with the renewal and extension of said  
15 corporation and the adoption of the amended, substituted, and  
16 renewal articles of incorporation, are hereby declared to be  
17 valid and legal.

1 Sec. 2. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and  
2 directed to acknowledge and file and record the certificate  
3 of renewal of said corporation previously delivered to him by  
4 said corporation, and to issue a certificate of renewal to  
5 the Strand Baking Company, said renewal to extend the corporate  
6 existence of said corporation for a period of twenty (20)  
7 years from the 31st day of July, 1944, which certificate of  
8 renewal shall have the same force and effect as though issued

9 upon proper and timely application of said corporation.

1     Sec. 3. Nothing in this act shall be deemed or construed  
2 to affect pending litigation, if any, involving said corpora-  
3 tion, or any claims outstanding against said corporation.

1     Sec. 4. This act, being deemed of immediate importance,  
2 shall be in full force from and after its publication in the  
3 Times Republican, a newspaper published in Marshalltown, Iowa,  
4 and in the State Center Enterprise, a newspaper published in  
5 State Center, Iowa, without expense to the State of Iowa.
