A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section four hundred nineteen point fifty-five (419.55), Code 1946, so as to exclude the management, supervision, direction and control of waterworks in certain cities from the duties and powers of a city manager appointed pursuant to chapter four hundred nineteen (419), Code 1946.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section four hundred nineteen point fifty-
2 five (419.55), Code 1946, is amended by striking the period
3 (.) at the end of paragraph five (5) thereof and by adding
4 to said paragraph five (5) the following: "and members of
5 boards of waterworks trustees."

1 Sec. 2. Section four hundred nineteen point fifty-five
2 (419.55), Code 1946, is amended by striking the period (.) at
3 the end of paragraph six (6) thereof and by adding to said
4 paragraph six (6) the following: "except as otherwise herein
5 provided."

1 Sec. 3. Section four hundred nineteen point fifty-five
2 (419.55), Code 1946, is amended by striking the period (.) at

3 the end of paragraph nine (9) thereof and by adding to said
4 paragraph nine (9) the following: "except as otherwise herein
5 provided."

1 Sec. 4. Section four hundred nineteen point fifty-five
2 (419.55), Code 1946, is amended by striking the period (.)
3 at the end of paragraph eleven (11) thereof and by adding to
4 said paragraph eleven (11) the following: "except as otherwise
5 herein provided."

1 Sec. 5. Section four hundred nineteen point fifty-five
2 (419.55), Code 1946, is amended by striking all of paragraph
3 twelve (12) thereof, and by substituting in lieu thereof the
4 following:

5 "12. He shall manage all municipal water plants, light-
6 ing, heating, or power plants, and transportation enterprises,
7 except waterworks owned by any city of twenty thousand (20,000)
8 inhabitants or more at the time of the adoption of the city
9 manager plan by any such city and at such time in the possession,
10 management and control of a board of waterworks trustees,
11 pursuant to applicable statutes. He shall have no duty or
12 power in respect to the property, purchasing of material,
13 hiring of employees, the making of improvements or extensions,
14 the operation or management of any such waterworks. The
15 adoption of the city manager plan by any such city shall not
16 in any manner or to any extent affect the powers and duties
17 of such boards of waterworks trustees or the manner of
18 appointment of members thereof or their terms of office or

19 the management or operation of any such waterworks.”

1 Sec. 6. This act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
3 and publication in the Plainfield News, a newspaper published
4 at Plainfield, Iowa, and in the Plain Talk, a newspaper
5 published in Des Moines, Iowa.
