A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section five hundred forty-four point sixteen (544.16), Code 1950, relating to funds of local warehouse boards.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section five hundred forty-four point sixteen
- 2 (544.16), Code 1950. is hereby repealed, and the following
- 3 section substituted in lieu thereof:
- 4 "Funds remaining in the treasury of the local warehouse
- 5 board on December 31, 1950 shall be distributed by the said
- 6 board to the boys and girls 4-H clubs of the county in which
- 7 the board is situated under such procedure as may be approved
- 8 by the secretary of agriculture.
- 9 "Funds turned over to the secretary of agriculture as
- 10 trustee shall be distributed to the county organization of
- 11 4-H clubs of the counties from which such funds were received.
- 12 The funds due each county shall be distributed to the boys and
- 13 girls 4-H clubs equally."

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 149

The activities of the local warehouse boards are being abandoned and instead of having a number of meetings and exhausting the funds of the local warehouse boards, this bill proposes to turn the money now in the treasury of the local warehouse boards over to 4-H Clubs.
