A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section three hundred twenty-one point
four hundred fifty-seven (321.457), Code 1950,
relating to maximum length of certain vehicles.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point
- 2 four hundred fifty-seven (321.457), Code 1950, is hereby
- 3 amended by inserting after the word "apparatus" in line
- 4 three (3) the following:
- 5 "and vehicles operated in the day time when
- 6 transporting poles, pipe, machinery or other objects of a
- 7 structural nature which cannot be dismembered readily
- 8 and such vehicles transporting such objects operated at
- 9 night time by a public utility when required for emergency
- 10 repair of public service facilities or properties, but
- 11 in respect to such night transportation every such vehicle
- 12 and the load thereon shall be equipped with a sufficient
- 13 number of clearance lamps on both sides and marker lamps
- 14 upon the extreme ends of any projecting load to mark
- 15 clearly the dimensions of such load".

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 222

This bill would exempt from length regulation the equipment used by utilities in emergency repair work when they must move poles over the highway. Such emergencies may occur at night or over the week end and should be classed the same as fire fighting equipment.

Amend House File 222 as follows:

Section one (1), line seven (7), by adding thereto after the word "readily" the following: "when required for emergency repair of public service facilities or properties,"
