A BILL FOR

An Act to promote reforestation in the State of Iowa and establish Arbor Day to be observed as a state holiday and encourage tree planting and conservation of natural resources.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. That hereafter, the 15th day of April
- 2 in each year shall be designated a state holiday to
- 3 be known as ARBOR DAY, for the purpose of encouraging
- 4 tree planting, reforestation and conservation of the
- 5 natural resources of the State of Iowa.
