# A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate twenty-four million dollars (\$24,000,000.00) from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the department of public instruction to general state aid for school districts as provided by chapter two hundred eighty-six A (286A), Code 1950.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general
- 2 fund of the state of Iowa to the department of public instruction
- 3 for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1953, and ending
- 4 June 30, 1955, the sum of twelve million dollars (\$12,000,000.00),
- 5 or so much thereof as may be necessary, for general state aid to
- 6 school districts as provided by chapter two hundred eighty-six A
- 7 (286A), Code 1950.
