## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section one hundred sixty-six point one (166.1), Code 1950, relating to hog cholera virus and serum.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred sixty-six point one
- 2 (166.1), sub-section 1, Code 1950, is hereby amended by
- 3 striking everything after the word "and" in line three (3)
- 4 and by substituting in lieu thereof the following: "viruses
- 5 which are either virulent or non-virulent, alive or dead."

- 1 Amend Senate File 147 by adding thereto as Sec. 2
- 2 the following:
- 3 "Sec. 2. Chapter one hundred sixty-six (166), Code
- 4 1950, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 5 "None of the provisions of this chapter as contained in
- 6 section one hundred sixty-six point sixteen (166.16) to
- 7 section one hundred sixty-six point twenty-eight (166.28),
- 8 inclusive, and section one hundred sixty-six point thirty
- 9 (166.30) to section one hundred sixty-six point thirty-three
- 10 (166.33), inclusive, relative to schools of instruction and
- 11 permits to purchase and administer virus shall be of any
- 12 force or effect where either a modified live virus of the
- 13 non-virulent type or dead virus vaccine is to be purchased
- 14 and administered."
