A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to Fern E. Sharp, Elkader, Iowa; Philip T. Hedin, Davenport, Iowa; Stanley L. Hart, Keokuk, Iowa; Morse E. Crosier, Coggon, Iowa; Howard E. Brookings, Oakland, Iowa; G. T. Clark, Knoxville, Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa, to Fern E. Sharp, Elkader,
3 Iowa, the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) in full
4 settlement of all claims which he may have against the
5 State of Iowa on account of services rendered as a member
6 of the Legislative Advisory Committee, State Office
7 Building.

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa, to Philip T. Hedin,
3 Davenport, Iowa, the sum of three hundred eighty dollars
4 (\$380.00) in full settlement of all claims which he may
5 have against the State of Iowa on account of services
6 rendered as a member of the Legislative Advisory Committee,
7 State Office Building.

1 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa, to Stanley L. Hart,
3 Keokuk, Iowa, the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00)
4 in full settlement of all claims which he may have
5 against the State of Iowa on account of services rendered
6 as a member of the Legislative Advisory Committee, State
7 Office Building.

1 Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa, to Morse E. Crosier,
3 Coggon, Iowa, the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00)
4 in full settlement of all claims which he may have
5 against the State of Iowa on account of services rendered
6 as a member of the Legislative Advisory Committee, State
7 Office Building.

1 Sec. 5. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa, to Howard E. Brookings,
3 Oakland, Iowa, the sum of three hundred sixty dollars
4 (\$360.00) in full settlement of all claims which he may
5 have against the State of Iowa on account of services
6 rendered as a member of the Legislative Advisory Committee,
7 State Office Building.

1 Sec. 6. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the State of Iowa, to G. T. Clark, Knoxville,
3 Iowa, the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) in full
4 settlement of all claims which he may have against the
5 State of Iowa on account of services rendered as a member

6 of the Legislative Advisory Committee, State Office
7 Building.

1 Sec. 7. The state comptroller is hereby authorized
2 to issue warrants to the above named parties in the
3 amounts stated, and the state treasurer is hereby directed
4 to pay the same from the general fund of the State of
5 Iowa.
