A BILL FOR

An Act providing for the establishment of a centralized printing department under the control of the state printing board bestowing upon the state printing board powers and duties to effectuate such establishment and to repeal section fifteen point thirty-three (15.33), Code of 1950.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Chapter fifteen (15), Code of 1950, is hereby amended by add-
2 ing thereto the following:

1 Section 1. A centralized printing department be and is hereby
2 established under the jurisdiction of the state printing board.

1 Sec. 2. With the exception only of mimeographs and similar dup-
2 licators, no department or agency of the state shall possess or
3 operate any presses, machines of the offset type, varitypes and
4 other printing machinery, and all such presses, machines of the
5 offset type, varitypes and other printing equipment owned by the
6 State of Iowa or possessed by any of its departments or agencies in
7 the city of Des Moines shall be centralized in a state building at
8 the city of Des Moines to be and remain under the control of the
9 state printing board.

1 Sec. 3. The state printing board is hereby authorized and
2 directed:

3 1. To possess itself of all such presses, machines of the off-
4 set type, varitypes and other printing equipment, inventory all of
5 such described equipment, and through the executive council sell
6 such of the above described machinery and equipment as is no
7 longer necessary or is unfit for use.

8 2. To maintain such machinery and equipment and in its dis-
9 cretion, when such equipment is out-moded and become obsolescent,
10 to purchase machinery and equipment for replacement purposes.

11 3. To make such printing department, its machinery and equip-
12 ment available for the state printing services when in its dis-
13 cretion it is to the best interests of the state that it, rather
14 than the contract procedure provided by section fifteen point six
15 (15.6), Code of 1950, shall be used; and to effectuate this power
16 and direction, the state printing board shall adopt suitable
17 rules and regulations for the administration and fulfillment of
18 the power and direction hereby imposed.

19 4. To install and maintain an accurate accounting system
20 appropriate and fitted to the purposes and the operations of this
21 department. Each official, board, department, commission or
22 agency shall requisition the state printing board for its print-
23 ing needs, accompanying such requisition with a statement of costs
24 of compilation and editorial work upon the material to be pub-
25 lished.

26 5. To avoid duplication, over-lapping and redundancy of
27 pamphlets and publications, other than official documents and
28 books and publications authorized by chapters fourteen (14) and

29 seventeen (17), Code of 1950, to examine the contents of proposed
30 pamphlets or publications and to approve or disapprove such
31 pamphlets or publications only for such reason; and to effectuate
32 this power, the state printing board shall adopt rules and regu-
33 lations for its administration.

1 Sec. 4. Each official, board, department, commission or agency
2 located outside the city of Des Moines, who maintains printing
3 equipment, or does any printing for the state or its departments
4 shall likewise keep an accurate cost system and make report
5 each June 30th to the printing board of such amounts, and these
6 shall be included in the biennial report of the state printing
7 board.

1 Sec. 5. Each official, board, department, commission and agency,
2 who as part of its membership fee provides pamphlets and books,
3 shall furnish all the costs of such publications. These costs
4 shall be included in their printing budget.

1 Sec. 6. Section fifteen point thirty-three (15.33), Code of
2 1950, be and is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:
3 "Each official, board, department, commission or agency of the
4 state shall file as part of its budget its estimate of expenditures
5 for printing for the ensuing biennium and such expenditure shall
6 be paid from its official, board, department, commission or agency
7 appropriation. Provided that such official, board, department,
8 commission or agency as possess a contingent or support or other
9 fund in the state treasury from which its printing costs are paid
10 shall operate thereunder until July 1, 1955. Section fifteen

11 point thirty-three (15.33). Code of 1950. shall be operative and
12 in full force and effect until July 1. 1955, and shall then stand
13 repealed."

1 Sec. 7. All mimeograph paper, envelopes and other paper stock
2 shall be drawn by the several state departments and agencies from
3 the state printing board with its approval and charged to the
4 several officials, boards, departments, commissions or agencies
5 and paid from the printing appropriation of each board, official,
6 department, commission or agency.
