A BILL FOR

An Act to direct and authorize payments to Iowa City public schools, Iowa City, Iowa, and the independent school district of Ames, Iowa, out of appropriations made to the university of Iowa, and Iowa state college, on account of pupils residing in tax free housing units.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. It is hereby directed and authorized that out
2 of the appropriation to the university of Iowa at Iowa City, made
3 by chapter six (6), section two (2), "For salaries, support,
4 maintenance and miscellaneous purposes", Acts of the Fifty-fourth
5 General Assembly, the sum of thirty-six thousand six hundred eighty-
6 three dollars eighty-seven cents (\$36,683.87) be paid to the
7 Iowa City public schools, Iowa City, Iowa, claim number one
8 hundred seventy-nine (179), in full settlement of all claims which
9 it may have against the state of Iowa, on account of pupils
10 residing in tax free housing units on the campus of the state
11 university at Iowa City and attending Iowa City public schools.

1 Sec. 2. It is hereby directed and authorized that out of
2 the appropriation to Iowa state college at Ames, made by chapter
3 six (6), section seven (7), "For general education", Acts of the
4 Fifty-fourth General Assembly, the sum of fifty-one thousand five

5 hundred ninety-three dollars twelve cents (\$51,593.12) be paid to
6 the independent school district, Ames, Iowa, claim number one
7 hundred eighty-four (184), in full settlement of all claims which
8 it may have against the state of Iowa, on account of pupils
9 residing in tax free housing units on the campus of Iowa state
10 college at Ames and attending the Ames public schools.

1 Sec. 3. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to
2 issue his warrants to the above named schools in the amounts
3 stated.

1 Sec. 4. Acceptance of said sums by the above named schools
2 shall be in full settlement of all claims against the state of
3 Iowa growing out of the operation of the housing units in said
4 cities.

1 Sec. 5. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall
2 take effect and be in full force from and after its publication
3 in the, a newspaper published at
4, Iowa, and in the,
5 a newspaper published at, Iowa.
