A BILL FOR

An Act relating to nets permitted in boundary rivers.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred nine point one hundred nine
2 (109.109), Code 1954, is hereby amended by striking from lines
3 fourteen (14), fifteen (15), sixteen (16), and seventeen (17), the
4 words "except that the material in the end opposite the throat
5 shall be of linen or cotton single mesh web with meshes not less
6 than one and one-half inches square or bar measure" and inserting
7 in lieu thereof the following: "The end opposite the throat shall
8 contain a hole not less than one and one-half inches in diameter."

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 282

This will eliminate a very high cost of reinserting these meshends in the basket traps on behalf of the fisherman, as he cannot treat this linen or cotton twine and the life of same is very short thereby making replacement a handicap to the basket trap fisherman.
