A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section one hundred ninety-eight point nine
(198.9), Code 1954, relating to the commercial feed fund.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 310

Additional research concerning livestock and poultry nutrition would not only help to enforce the commercial feed law, but would benefit the livestock and poultry producers of the state of Iowa. Such research is especially needed at this time because of the new developments of vitamins, antibiotics, diethylstilbestrol and other hormones. The 10 cents per ton inspection fee is not a revenue measure, but is a regulatory measure and brings into the state of Iowa approximately \$184,000 annually. This is more than is needed for administration and inspection service of said law. The 10 cents per ton inspection fee in the end is finally paid by the livestock and poultry producers who use commercial feeds. They should be protected.
