# A BILL FOR

AN ACT making appropriations for payment of miscellaneous expense incurred or authorized by the Fifty-sixth General Assembly.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds
- 2 in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the following
- 3 sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, in payment of
- 4 miscellaneous expenses incurred or authorized by the Fifty-sixth
- 5 General Assembly:
- 6 A. C. Gustafson, Chief Clerk of the House, for postage
- 7 and miscellaneous expenses after adjournment. (This shall
- 8 be in addition to postage left over in the House post office
- 9 after the session has adjourned) .....\$ 200.00
- 10 Carroll A. Lane, Secretary of the Senate, for postage
- 11 and miscellaneous expenses after adjournment. (This shall
- 12 be in addition to postage left over in the Senate post office
- 13 after the session has adjourned) ..... 100.00
- 14 Executive Council for legislative photographs, tele-
- 15 phone, telegraph, supplies, postage and miscellaneous
- 16 expense incurred during the 56th General Assembly and sub-

17 sequent to its adjournment and during the session of the  
 18 57th General Assembly, including the compensation of a  
 19 legislative supply clerk if necessary. The amount herein  
 20 appropriated shall be used only in the payment of bills  
 21 actually authorized by the General Assembly and for supplies  
 22 requisitioned by the proper officers of the General Assembly \$7,500.00

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated a sum sufficient to  
 2 pay the compensation made necessary by House Concurrent Resolution  
 3 No. 21 for services required of officers and employees of the  
 4 Fifty-sixth General Assembly after final adjournment, and prior  
 5 to the convening of the 57th General Assembly.

1 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated an additional sum of  
 2 forty-thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) or so much thereof as may be  
 3 necessary for the payment of the cost of printing for the Fifty-  
 4 sixth General Assembly, and the state comptroller is hereby  
 5 authorized to issue warrants against said appropriation upon

6 requisition by the superintendent of printing.

1     Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated a sum sufficient to  
2 pay the actual expense incurred by members of the Fifty-sixth  
3 General Assembly who have been designated by the Federal Civil  
4 Defense Administration as Atomic Test Observers for what is  
5 militarily termed the "Open Shot" Atomic Explosion in Nevada, as  
6 provided in House Concurrent Resolution No. 19 and the state  
7 comptroller is hereby authorized to issue warrants in favor of  
8 said individuals on presentation covering such expense.

1     Sec. 5. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to  
2 make available any unexpended balance of the appropriation of  
3 seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00) made to the  
4 executive council in Chapter 24 of the 55th General Assembly  
5 for legislative expenses in order that such balance may be  
6 applied to the payment of legislative expenses of the 56th  
7 General Assembly.

1     Sec. 6. There is hereby appropriated to the executive  
2 council an amount sufficient to cover the cost of reupholstering  
3 and repairing the chairs used by the members of the General  
4 Assembly and for the purchase of new chairs for the legislative  
5 secretaries.

1     Sec. 7. There is hereby appropriated to A. C. Gustafson,  
2 Chief Clerk of the House of Representative, the sum of four  
3 hundred sixty-six dollars thirty-five cents (\$466.35) to reim-  
4 burse him for his actual expenses in attending the Legislative  
5 Service Conference of the Council of State Government at New

6 Orleans in 1953 and San Francisco in 1954.

1 Sec. 8. There is hereby appropriated to the executive  
2 council the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary for the installation of venetian  
4 blinds in the windows of the senate and house chambers.

1 Sec. 9. There is hereby appropriated to the executive  
2 council an amount sufficient to pay the cost of recarpeting  
3 the senate chamber.

1 Sec. 10. There is hereby appropriated a sufficient amount  
2 to pay additional compensation to the following named officers  
3 of the 56th General Assembly in connection with the 56th General  
4 Assembly:

- 5 To Carroll A. Lane, Secretary of the Senate.....\$500.00
- 6 To A. C. Gustafson, Chief Clerk of the House.....\$500.00

1 Sec. 11. This Act being deemed of immediate importance  
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and  
3 publication in the Perry Daily Chief, a newspaper published at  
4 Perry, Iowa, and the Marshalltown Times-Republican, a newspaper  
5 published at Marshalltown, Iowa.



1 1. Amend House File 590 by changing the title to read:  
2 "AN ACT making appropriations for payment of miscellaneous  
3 expense incurred or authorized by the Fifty-sixth  
4 General Assembly and amending Chapter two, Code 1954,  
5 to provide for an expense allowance for members of  
6 the Fifty-seventh and subsequent General Assemblies."  
7 2. Further amend House File 590 by adding the following  
8 section:  
9 "Section two point eleven (2.11), Code 1954, is amended  
10 by adding the following sentence at the end thereof: 'In addition,  
11 each member of the Fifty-seventh and subsequent general assem-  
12 blies,  
13 including the speaker and the lieutenant governor, shall receive as  
14 additional compensation an expense allowance of ten dollars (\$10)  
per day for the actual  
duration of each full regular session and for each extra session.'"

7 including the Speaker and the Lieutenant Governor, shall receive

9 (\$12) per day for the actual duration of each full regular session  
and

inserting
