Code 1954, and to enact a substitute therefor, relating to
the regulation of the business of buying, selling,
receiving, or dealing in eggs.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 17 records of all purchases of eggs, which record shall be kept *See*
- 18 available for six months for inspection by the department." *See*

- 20 (5) after the word "number" the following: "if any". *See*
- 21 4. Further amend Senate File 83 by adding the following
- 22 new section.
- 23 "This Act shall be in full force and effect from January 1,
- 24 1956 until July 4, 1957".
