A BILL FOR

An Act to prescribe the hours of the day during which chauffeurs and operators under the age of eighteen (18) may drive motor vehicles.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter three hundred twenty-one (321), Code
2 1954, is amended by adding thereto the following new section:
3 "Any licensed chauffeur or operator under the age of
4 eighteen (18) years shall not operate a motor vehicle between
5 the hours of 12:00 midnight and 5 a.m. Upon receiving
6 satisfactory evidence that any such chauffeur or operator has
7 violated this restriction, the department shall suspend his
8 license for a period of not less than thirty (30) days nor more
9 than six (6) months. This restriction shall not extend nor
10 affect any other restriction limiting the hours during which
11 any such chauffeur or operator may operate a motor vehicle,
12 but shall be in addition thereto."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 152

This bill would limit the driving hours of persons under the age of 18 to the period between 5 a.m. and midnight. Violators would be subject to a mandatory suspension of their license.
