## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to mileage allowances of petit and grand jurors.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section six hundred seven point five (607.5),
- 2 Code 1954, is hereby amended as follows:
- 3 1. By inserting in line five (5) of subsection one (1)
- 4 after the word, "trial" the words, "for each days service and
- 5 attendance".
- 6 2. By inserting in line five (5) of subsection three (3)
- 7 after the word, "traveled" the words, "each day from his
- 8 residence to the place of attendance and".
- 9 3. By adding at the end of subsection three (3) the
- 10 following:
- 11 "No grand juror shall receive mileage for travel in the
- 12 performance of his duties when he travels in a vehicle for
- 13 which another juror is receiving mileage."

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 159

The purpose of this bill is to clearly establish that grand and petit jurors receive mileage pay for traveling to the courthouse for each day's attendance, but that no juror shall receive mileage if he travels in a vehicle for which another juror is receiving mileage pay.

### HOUSE FILE 159

- 1 Amend House File 159 by inserting after line ten (10)
- 2 the following:
- 3 "Provided, however, that grand jurors shall be entitled
- 4 to mileage for travel from the place of their residence to
- 5 the county seat for the purpose of being impaneled."
