A BILL FOR

An Act to provide when the proposition of county
conservation boards can be submitted to the voters.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section five (5), chapter twelve (12), Acts
- 2 of the Fifty-sixth General Assembly, is hereby amended by
- 3 striking the word, "regular" in line three (3) and inserting
- 4 in lieu thereof the words, "primary or general".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 550

The purpose of this bill is to clarify at what kind of an election the establishment of a county conservation board can be submitted to the voters. Primary elections are not elections within the meaning of the constitution in Iowa, therefore such elections would not fall within the purview of "regular" elections as the act now provides.
