A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the special reserve fund of the state of Iowa to the state conservation commission funds for construction, replacement, repairs, acquisition of land, development, forestry, watershed area improvements, design and investigation, and dredging.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections
2 eight point forty-one (8.41), eight point forty-two (8.42)
3 and eight point forty-three (8.43) of the Code, there is
4 hereby appropriated and set out of the the special reserve fund
5 of the state from moneys not otherwise appropriated, to
6 the state conservation commission the sum of one million five
7 hundred dollars (\$1,500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary for construction, acquisition, replacements,
9 alterations for state parks and reserves, state forests, state
10 waters, for dredging, for artificial lake development, for
11 erosion control, for streams and lake access, for land ac-
12 quisition and for design and investigation.

1 Sec. 2. Said sum shall be allocated in the following
2 amounts:

1 Sec. 3. The funds appropriated and set aside by this Act
2 shall not be expended until it shall be determined by the
3 conservation commission with approval of the budget and financial
4 control committee that its expenditures shall be for the best
5 interests of the state.

1 Sec. 4. The treasurer of the state of Iowa is hereby
2 empowered to invest any of the funds so appropriated and set
3 aside by the provisions of section one (1) of this Act in
4 securities of the United States Government.

1 Sec. 5. When contracts, plans or specifications for

2 improvements for which funds are herein appropriated have been
 3 accepted by the conservation commission, and approved by the
 4 budget and financial control committee of the state of Iowa, the
 5 state treasurer is authorized and directed to sell sufficient
 6 securities herein provided in section two (2) of this Act to cover
 7 the cost of said improvement.

1 Sec. 6. The provisions of all acts or statutes in
 2 conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this act
 3 are hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 7. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence,
 2 clause, or phrase of this act is for any reason held to be
 3 unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or
 4 invalidity shall not affect the constitutionality or validity
 5 of the remaining portions of this act. The General Assembly
 6 hereby declares that it would have passed this act and
 7 each section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or
 8 phrase hereof irrespective of whether any one or more of
 9 the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be
 10 declared unconstitutional.

HOUSE FILE 601

1 Amend House File 601 by inserting the following as Section 6
 2 and renumbering the remaining sections:
 3 "In the dredging or reconstruction of any artificial lake or
 4 natural lake and which funds may be appropriated by the General
 5 Assembly, the state conservation commission shall not proceed with
 6 actual construction work unless and until soil conservation practices
 7 are in effect on at least seventy-five percentum of the land comprising
 8 the watershed of the proposed impoundment, or a willingness to carry
 9 on such practices shall have been shown by the owners or operators
 10 of seventy-five percentum of said land by signing of a soil
 11 conservation farm plan and cooperative agreements with the local
 12 soil conservation district governing body."

1 Amend House File 601 as follows:
 2 By striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu
 3 thereof the following:
 4 "Section 1. There is hereby appropriated and set out of the
 5 special reserve fund of the state from any moneys not otherwise
 6 appropriated, to the state conservation commission, the sum of
 7 one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
 8 necessary for construction, acquisition, replacements, alterations
 9 for state parks and reserves, state forests, state waters, for
 10 dredging, for artificial lake development, for erosion control,
 11 for streams and lake access, for land acquisition and for design
 12 and investigation, but said funds appropriated and set aside by
 13 this Act shall not be expended until it shall be determined by
 14 the conservation commission with approval of the budget and
 15 financial control committee that its expenditures shall be for
 16 the best interests of the state, provided, however, that none
 17 of such funds shall be expended for new projects.
 18 Sec. 2. The treasurer of the state of Iowa is hereby
 19 empowered to invest any of the funds so appropriated and set
 20 aside by the provisions of section one (1) of this Act in
 21 securities of the United States Government.
 22 Sec. 3. When contracts, plans or specifications for
 23 improvements for which funds are herein appropriated have been
 24 accepted by the conservation commission, and approved by the
 25 budget and financial control committee of the state of Iowa,
 26 the state treasurer is authorized and directed to sell sufficient
 27 securities herein provided in section two (2) of this Act to
 28 cover the cost of said improvement.
 29 Sec. 4. The provisions of all acts or statutes in conflict
 30 or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby
 31 repealed.
 32 Sec. 5. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence,
 33 clause, or phrase of this Act is for any reason held to be
 34 unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or
 35 invalidity shall not affect the constitutionality or validity
 36 of the remaining portions of this Act. The General Assembly
 37 hereby declares that it would have passed this Act and each
 38 section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
 39 hereof irrespective of whether any one or more of the sections,
 40 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared
 41 unconstitutional."
