An Act to amend chapter three hundred twenty-four (324), Code 1954, relating to the filing of claims for refund of the tax on gasoline.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Amend section three hundred twenty-four point
2 fifty (324.50), Code 1954, by striking the words, "shall be
3 verified by the oath of the claimant" in lines seventeen (17)
4 and eighteen (18) and substituting in lieu thereof the words,
5 "shall be certified by the claimant under penalty for false
6 certificate".

1 Sec. 2. Amend section three hundred twenty-four point
2 fifty-seven (324.57), Code 1954, by striking the words, "made
3 under oath" in line nine (9) and substituting in lieu thereof
4 the words, "certified by the applicant under penalty for false
5 certificate" and by striking the last sentence and substituting
6 in lieu thereof, "A refund permit shall continue in effect until
7 revoked as hereinafter provided."

1 Sec 3. Chapter three hundred twenty-four (324), Code 1954,
2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section:
3 "Revocation of Refund Permit. Any refund permit issued under
4 this chapter may be revoked by the treasurer for any of the
5 following violations, but only after the holder of the permit
6 has been given reasonable notice of the intention to revoke the

7 permit and reasonable opportunity to be heard:

8 1. Using in support of a refund claim a false or
9 altered invoice;

10 2. Making a false statement in a claim for refund or in
11 response to an investigation by the treasurer of a claim for
12 refund; or

13 3. Refusal to submit his books and records for examination
14 by the treasurer or his authorized representative.

15 A person whose refund permit is revoked for cause as above
16 provided may not obtain another refund permit for a period of
17 one year after the revocation.

18 A refund permit under which no refund is claimed for a period
19 of one year from date of issuance or a refund permit whose holder
20 has moved from the county wherein he resided at the time of
21 application for said permit shall be revoked by the treasurer
22 subject to reinstatement or issuance of a new permit as provided
23 in section three hundred twenty-four point fifty-seven (324.57),
24 Code 1954."

1 Sec. 4. Amend section three hundred twenty-four point
2 fifty-nine (324.59), Code 1954, by adding the words, "or false
3 certificate," after the comma (,) in line two (2) and by adding
4 the words, "or certificate" after the word, "affidavit" in line
5 three (3).
