# A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section two point eleven (2.11), two point thirteen (2.13), and two point fourteen (2.14), Code 1954, relating to compensation of members of the general assembly, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section two point eleven (2.11), Code 1954, is  
2 hereby amended by striking all after line two (2) and inserting  
3 in lieu thereof the following: "To every member, for each full  
4 regular session, the sum of twenty (20) dollars per day but not  
5 less than two thousand (2,000) dollars, plus an allowance for  
6 expenses of one thousand (1,000) dollars, and for each extra  
7 session the compensation of twenty (20) dollars per day, plus an  
8 allowance for expenses of ten (10) dollars per day, while in  
9 session; and in going to and returning from the place where the  
10 general assembly is held, seven (7) cents per mile, by the near-  
11 est traveled route, for each regular session and for each extra  
12 session, plus a like amount for each round trip actually made  
13 during any session but not in excess of one (1) per week.

1 Sec. 2. Section two point thirteen (2.13), Code 1954, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "compensation" in  
3 lines one (1) and three (3) thereof the words "and allowance

4 for expense".

1 Sec. 3. Section two point fourteen (2.14), Code 1954, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "compensation" in  
3 lines three (3) and five (5) thereof the words "and allowance  
4 for expenses".

1 Sec. 4. This Act shall be effective beginning with the fifty-  
2 eighth general assembly.

EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 372

This bill is designed to enable members of the General Assembly to receive a reasonable allowance for expenses and also a realistic mileage allowance for weekend trips home to visit with their constituents.

10 each extra session.'

12 hereby amended by striking all after line four (4) and inserting  
13 in lieu thereof the following: 'be paid the sum of thirty (30)  
14 dollars per day during the remainder of such session.'

15 "Sec. 3. This Act shall be effective beginning with the  
16 fifty-eighth general assembly."
