A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to members of the Iowa Study Committee on Water Rights and Drainage Laws, namely: Conway E. Morris, Wendell Pendleton, Carl T. Anderson, A. J. Johnson, James Hudson, James Foster and George Ahrens.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the state of Iowa to the following named
3 persons the amounts set opposite their respective names in
4 full settlement of all claims which they may have against the
5 state of Iowa on account of services rendered as a member of
6 the Iowa study committee of water rights and drainage laws,
7 to-wit:

1 Sec. 2. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to
2 issue his warrants to the above named parties in the amounts
3 stated, and the treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same
4 from the designated funds or accounts of the state of Iowa.

1 Sec. 3. The acceptance of said sums by the above named

2 parties shall be in full settlement of all claims against the
3 state of Iowa growing out of the above described claims.

1 Sec. 4. This Act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall take effect and be in full force from and after its
3 publication in The Wellman Advance, a newspaper published at
4 Wellman, Iowa and the Storm Lake Pilot-Tribune, a newspaper
5 published at Storm Lake, Iowa.
