 2 hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state for each  
 3 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1957, and ending June 30,  
 4 1959, the sum of ninety two thousand dollars (\$92,000.00)  
 5 or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used in the  
 6 following manner:
